The future World of Work is changing rapidly.

Recent research conducted by the *Foundation for Young Australians* suggests young people today will have up to 17 jobs across 5 different industries, and that automation, globalisation and collaboration will be the key drivers of the post-Industrial age Knowledge Economy.

What we do know is that what we work on, where we work and how we work will change dramatically, and that with the demise of progressive linear career pathways and the rise of the gig economy, young people today will need to build high-value transferable skills and design fluid 'portfolio' careers in order to maintain relevance in a competitive future marketplace.

Yet research reveals many young people believe they lack the necessary interview skills (26%), job application skills (25%) and soft and hard skills to be able to attain full-time work in the future.

So how do we equip today's students with the transferable soft and hard skills they will need to survive and thrive in tomorrow's shifting marketplace?

These key skills will include critical and inventive thinking, communication, collaboration, digital literacy, creativity, global awareness and cross-cultural understandings, leadership and presentation skills, teamwork, agility, problem solving, Design Thinking and financial literacy.

This workshop focuses on individual student 'Future of Work' knowledge and skill-building using industry insights, real-world case studies, interactive workplace mentor videos and world-leading research and marketplace prediction data about global workforce shifts and critical skills of the future.

Students will explore and identify existing personal skills and industry interest areas, be introduced to and understand jobs and industries of the future, and develop a personal roadmap to enable proactive career skill-building conversations with parents and school career advisers so they can make more informed choices about subjects, courses and future pathway planning.

Students will also be provided with context, frameworks and 21st Century core capability tools to enable comprehensive understandings and applications for resumes, work experience prospecting and placements and future workplace opportunities.
